- Board positions are a two year commitment.
- Board Members are required to follow the SPJFL bi-laws, MVJF & C bi-laws and codes of conduct.
- In addition to regular board positions requirements, board members are required to attend board meetings (at least monthly),
- Board members are required to attend and participate in various program activities including but not limited to:
 - Home games
 - all program registrations
 - summer camps
 - equipment handouts
- Community events-MVJF&C also has the opportunity to participate in various community events, either to promote the program, or to fundraise. Some events that require participation are Maple Valley Days parade, Rhythm and Blues (concessions fundraiser), Fourth of July (concessions fund raiser).
- Some board members are required or encouraged to attend the SPJFL League meetings (board meetings, director meetings, etc).
